10. Vaquitas and Hector’s dolphins are critically endangered and the Yangtze River dolphin is now extinct. What is the difference between endangered and extinct? List some reason you THINK may have caused the population of these three species to decline.
11. If you have been to a dolphin show, describe the behaviors that you saw the dolphins do. If you haven’t been to a dolphin show, find a partner who has been to explain to you what he/she saw or explain what you think a dolphin show might be like.
12. Describe how life in captivity is different than life in the ocean for a dolphin. Be as descriptive as you can.

14. What do you a dolphin show teaches children about dolphins?
