

Dolphin Vocabulary

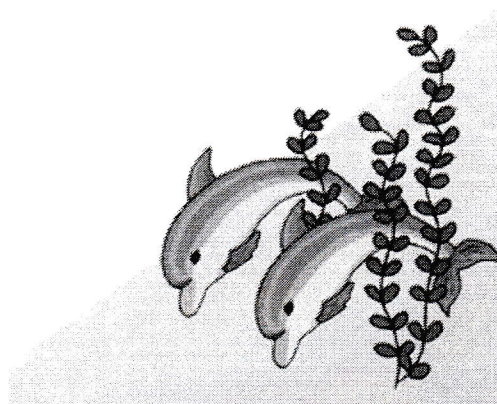
- **Cetacean**~an order of marine mammal
- **Fluke**~each lobe of the dolphin's tail
- **Blowhole**~a dolphin breathes through this
- **Dorsal fin**~acts as a keel giving some stability as the dolphin
- **Swims**~pectoral fin (dolphins use these to steer)
- **Carnivorous**~flesh eating
- **Herbivorous**~plant eating
- **Omnivorous**~plant and animal eating
- **Dolphin**~a cetacean mammal in the family Delphinidae
- **Mammal**~warm blooded vertebrate animal
- **Calf**~a baby dolphin
- **Cow**~ a mother dolphin
- **Bull**~a father dolphin
- **Bottlenose**~a common type of dolphin
- **Pod**~a group of dolphins
